VICTORY

Contributions to Trump Victory (“TV”) are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires us to use best efforts to collect and report contributors’ names, mailing addresses, occupations, and employers.

TV is a joint fundraising committee composed of Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. (“DJTP”), the Republican National Committee (“RNC”), and the official Republican state parties in Arkansas, Connecticut, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Jersey, New York, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wyoming (“State Parties”). Contributions from individuals (multicandidate PACs in parentheses) shall be allocated sequentially according to the following formula: \$2,700 (\$5,000) to DJTP; \$133,600 (\$60,000) to the RNC; \$110,000 (\$55,000) split evenly among the State Parties; \$200,400 (\$90,000) to the RNC.

Notwithstanding this allocation formula, a contributor may designate a contribution for a specific participant or participants. In addition, the allocation formula may change if any contribution would exceed applicable contribution limits.
